

# FAIRLINGTON COMMONS COUNCIL OF CO-OWNERS TENNIS COURT RULES

The following rules are enforceable by the Fairlington Commons Board of Directors and the Tennis Chair. The Board of Directors may suspend or revoke a Co-Owner or Resident's Court privileges if these rules are violated.

The following are expressly not allowed:

Alcohol or other controlled substances	Non-Tennis footwear (sandals, thongs, etc.)
Glass containers	Pets
Littering	Profanity
Loud sounds	Skate boards, roller blades, etc.

This Court is for the use of Fairlington Commons Co-Owners and Residents ONLY. Guests may play on the Court ONLY when accompanied by a Co-Owner or Resident. The use of this Court by a Co-Owner or Resident to provide Tennis Instruction for compensation to non-Co-Owners or non-Residents is not allowed. The use of this Court by a Co-Owner or Resident to receive professional instruction is permitted only within the constraints of these rules.

The Court shall be used for TENNIS ONLY. No other use is permitted.

The Court reservation system shall be in effect on Saturdays, Sundays, Holidays, and weekdays after 5:00 PM. No person shall reserve more than ONE HOUR per day on weekdays. No two players shall reserve consecutive hours for singles play on weekdays. Doubles shall be limited to one hour on weekdays. At all other times, play by any member of the same party shall be limited to two consecutive hours. Reservations shall begin and end on the hour.

Sign-Up - Weekday Sign-Up begins at 9:00 P.M. for play on the following day only. Weekend and Holiday Sign-Up begins at 7:30 A.M. for play on that day only. If two or more Residents arrive simultaneously to sign-up for the Court for the same time period, a coin toss shall be held to determine who is awarded the period in question/contention.

Players who do not appear at the Court within 10 minutes of their reserved hour shall forfeit their reservations. If available, the clock at the pool shall serve as the official time.

Children under the age of 14 shall not be allowed to use the Court after 5:00 P.M. if adults wish to play. This provision does not apply if an adult has made the reservation and is playing with children.

Two people shall take precedence over one person on the Court. **Players taking the Court at their reserved time shall display their Fairlington Commons Recreational Pass.**

Co-Owners and Residents shall not share the gate lock combination with non-Residents. At the conclusion of play, the gate shall be locked unless another party is physically present and waiting to play.

The roller is for Tennis Court use only.
