Mark your calendar for these neighborhood events:

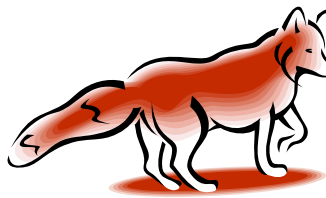

Safety is Key



Several residents have reported seeing foxes roam the Arbor during the day. Please do not approach these wild animals – on May 9th a

woman in the 5100 block of S. 12 Road was bit by a fox, which later tested positive for rabies. Also, please do not feed the foxes as it will make them dependent on us and will remove any reservations they may have about approaching us. If you see one behaving in a strange or aggressive manner, call the Animal Welfare League at (703) 931-9241.

Please use the rear entrance, off the pool service road. Note that parking on the pad and drive is limited to the CFM Manager or his designated representative and the facility manager.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Trash pickup. Monday thru Saturday, except Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Put securely tied bags out between 6:00am and 8:00am on the day of pickup. Do not place trash outside the night before as it attracts rodents and other animals.

Large items. Regularly scheduled pickup is on the 1st Saturday of the month. Please keep our property respectable and do not place items outside prior.

Recycling. Receptacles for mixed glass, plastics (with screw on tops or necks narrower than the base), and cans (aluminum and steel) are put out on Tuesdays and collected on Wednesdays.

Newspapers should be securely tied with string or placed in paper bags. Corrugated boxes must be broken down and placed besides the receptacles. For mixed paper, catalogs, and magazines, please use the Arlington County Recycling Center, Four Mile Run at Columbia Pike.
