Glen Gets Trees from Arlington County Without Charge

Alison Trimble has been working tirelessly for Fairlington Glen to obtain trees under the Arlington County Tree Canopy Fund. The County requires that tree recipients commit to watering them. The final application is due on July 8, and approval notices are expected in August. Approved plantings will occur anytime between October and December, depending on the weather and contractor schedule. As more funds become available, the Glen may be able to obtain even more trees, so if you missed an opportunity to have a tree planted nearby in this funding cycle, you may get another opportunity.

Vacancies on the Glen's Board

A vibrant, lively community such as ours needs volunteers in many roles, both on committees and as Board members. In Fairlington Glen, Board members serve a 3-year term, staggered so that in any given year 1 or 2 terms are completed. In November Kathy Clatanoff, currently President, and Margaret Windus, currently Treasurer, are both rotating off the Board, leaving two vacancies to fill. There will be a formal call for candidate nominations at the end of the summer, but in the meantime, please consider volunteering to join the Board in November.

The Board determines the direction of our community. Formal meetings are for two hours, once each month, usually at the Community Center. Between meetings, Board members interact with Glen residents and owners who have questions or concerns, but these days that interaction is usually by email. Most day-to-day details are taken care of by our Nelson Ordonez and Maria Castro, our on-site staff, or by Cardinal Management.

There is no salary, but the rewards are significant in terms of contributing to one's community. While there are no formal prerequisites for the job, it does help to have an open mind, a desire to reach out to others, a penchant for conflict resolution, and a willingness to take responsibility for decisions.

Repairs and Resurfacing of Tennis Courts

The Glen's Board has approved in concept repairs to the Glen's tennis courts, both the Single Court by the pool and the Three Courts on S. Stafford St. Repairs are slated to begin in mid-July after formal approval of a contract at the July 12 Board meeting. The surfaces at both sites will be replaced and receive new color coating: blue (on the playing surface) and green (off the playing surface). This is the standard color coating for courts at the U.S. Open Tennis Facility in NY. The Three Courts will also get new black vinyl fencing. Please be patient during the several weeks repairs take place. While every attempt will be made to have courts at one site available for play while the other is being repaired, there will be some overlap of down time. Will Smith, tennis chair, is coordinating this effort.

Better Mail Boxes for B Buildings

At its June meeting, the Board approved a \$9,959.00 contract with Mid Atlantic Mail Boxes for installation of improved mail boxes in the B building units. Many thanks to Jay Yianilos for working with Cardinal Management on the design specifications and coordinating with B-building residents.

Damage Control During Sewer Back-Ups

In the Glen, units in the same building-group share a common sewer drain running outside the building, so a back-up in one unit can affect, and be affected by, other units in the building. If a back-up occurs in a unit, the remaining units in that building units should be requested *immediately* to cease doing anything that causes liquid to go down the pipes: using the dish washer, the clothes washer, and the disposal; showering; flushing the toilet, running water, etc. While back-ups have been reduced by our replacement and relining projects, they will never be entirely eliminated.

Repairs of Basketball Court

One of the poles at the basketball court has fallen. After over 35 years of slam dunks, the pole at one end finally called it quits. Pat Murray, basketball chair, is investigating options to replace both poles and repair the sunken area as well. Please be patient during downtime for repairs, and keep children off the court.

Board to Develop Variance Policy for Owner Installation of Outside Lights

Certain residents may prefer to install outside lights to improve visibility and safety. This requires a variance. To ensure that such installation does not detract from curb appeal, minimizes future maintenance problems, and does not impinge on the privacy of neighbors, the Board, at its June meeting, expressed an intent to develop a policy governing the approval of variances.

Nelson and María Come Through Again!

Kudos to Glen staff Nelson Ordoñez and María Castro for designing, making, and installing the new additions to our 20 court signs (some courts have more than one) so that they now provide the non-emergency number for Arlington County police. Towing companies must report all tows to the County police; towing signs must include the police number. Thank you, Nelson and María.
